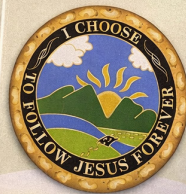

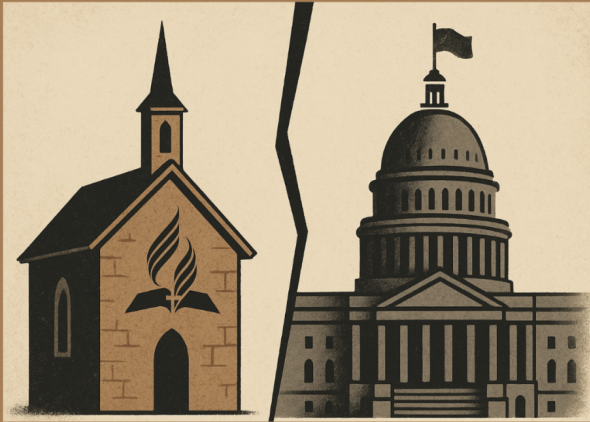
PRAYER AND REVIVAL MEETING
