FINANCIAL GIVING UPDATE

We had a very strong July with more than \$40,000 given to church budget. The surplus of \$10,000 helped replenish our budget reserves, which were running low. Our treasurer reports that every month, new people are contributing to the church financially. Praise the Lord! Let's continue to journey together financially. Along with faithfully returning tithe, remember that we have two major areas of ongoing local need:

1. Church Budget \$29,786//month.
2. Church mortgage: \$23,723/month. (Note: Our church mortgage has nearly reached 2 months' of reserves, which allows us to pay down our principal faster. So extra gifts are very welcome.)

Typically in a North American Adventist church, about 50% of church attendees give financially. Our giving at Ooltewah SDA is slightly higher than that. But if we all give something each month, we'll have abundant resources for ministry. Giving is always a personal and private decision, and some can give more than others. (Some members can only give \$50/month, while others can give \$500/month.) The important thing is that we journey together as a church family. July was a month to rejoice.
