

into a full symphony; it is now a music ministry provided by the Ooltewah SDA Church. The group includes a variety of volunteer members including musicians from the Ooltewah SDA Church, the OAKS School, Collegedale Academy, SAU, and surrounding Collegedale, Chattanooga, and Ooltewah communities.

The string orchestra has grown to include woodwind and brass instruments, developing

As part of the Ooltewah SDA Music Ministries, its purpose is threefold: 1) To provide music for worship services, 2) to provide a training organization for young musicians who derive inspiration by playing next to more professional and experienced players, and 3) to provide a place for anyone that enjoys making music to fellowship together.

New members are needed, especially string players! Do you play oboe, French horn, or bassoon? There are needs for wind players as well. HSO meets every Thursday, 6:30-7:45 PM in Ooltewah SDA Sanctuary during the school year (Sometimes in the Fellowship Hall). Friday rehearsals meet the day before Sabbath performances from 6:30-7:45 PM.

The group usually performs two to three times a semester with optional invitational performances at surrounding churches depending on the individual availability of orchestra members.

*String players (including harp) need at least 1 year of lessons/playing experience and can read music. Wind/brass/percussion players need to be at high school level or adults that have previously played. All new musicians will have an informal meeting with the director, Mary Wilcox, at their first rehearsal. The first rehearsals serves as a "test-drive" for new musicians to decide whether or not the group is right for them.
