## **Covenant Sabbath**

This Sabbath is Covenant Sabbath, the beginning of our Fall Capstone Campaign, with the goal of paying off our \$2.9 million debt in three years.

**Here's how Capstone works:** In the church lobby, you'll see a Giving Pyramid with colorful pins. On the lower half of the pyramid, you'll see pins representing all those who have given before: 298 donors and \$3.6 million. On the upper half of the pyramid, you'll see colorful new pins representing new pledges toward our remaining building debt of \$2.9 million.

- 1. Capstone is for any and all new donations toward the new sanctuary. So If you're planning to contribute toward the building over the next three years, you can submit a pledge card and a pin will be placed on the pyramid representing your pledge. If you're giving monthly toward the sanctuary, you can tally your expected giving and pledge accordingly. Even if you're still fulfilling past pledges toward the debt, you can make a new pledge, representing planned future giving.
- 2. Pledges range from \$1000 to \$500,000, based on three years of planned giving. So if you give \$50/month, that's \$1800 total (green pin) over three years. If you give \$100/month, that's \$3600 (orange pin) over three years. If you give \$1000/month, that's \$36,000 (black pin) over three years. Here are the pledges we need to pay off our debt:

#### MY GIVING POTENTIAL

Consistently giving a little builds a large gift. We can contribute far more than we think by spreading our giving over a three-year period.

(Note: Since we're paying interest monthly at about 50% of our current payment, there's great benefit in paying off our debt as quickly as possible. For example, if a donor were to give \$300,000, this would be the equivalent of 13 months in mortgage payments, or \$156,000 in interest saved.)

- 3. To make a Capstone pledge, please fill out a pledge card in your bulletin or at the Capstone table in the lobby. You can submit your pledge card, and a colorful pin will be placed on the pyramid for you.
- **4.** Along with our main Capstone pyramid, we also have a Capstone for Kids pyramid, with pledges ranging from \$10 to \$100+. How special to have our children feel part of our Capstone campaign—like the boy-king Joash and his treasure chest.

Our Capstone campaign will continue through December. In the steps of the Bible's great faith heroes, let's fix our eyes on Jesus and make this journey together in biblical community.
