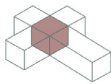

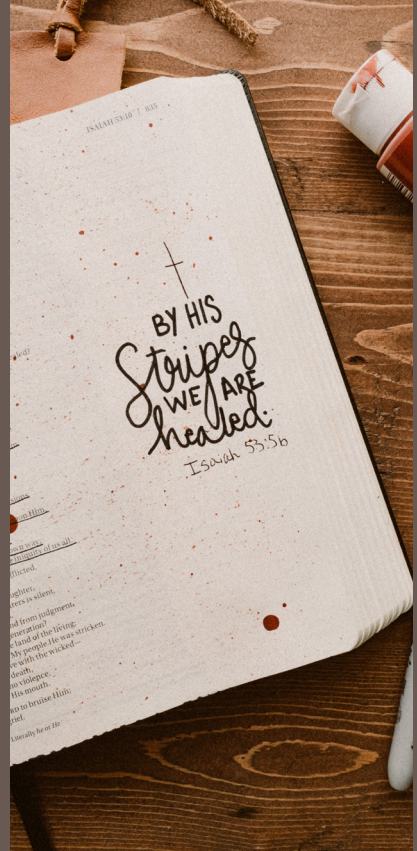

- Feel free to introduce yourself to the new division leaders. We love getting to know our families!



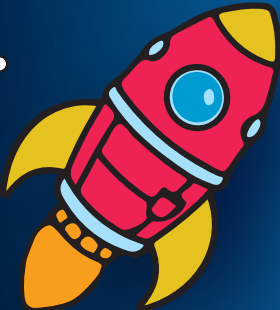
